The Hawks entered the tournament as the second ranked team in Region IA with only two losses during the regular season. In the tournament, they defeated

Tabernacle Christian of Greenville before losing to Mountain View Christian Academy of Cowpens in the semi-finals. In the consolation game, Hawthorne defeated Heritage Christian of Gaffney to win third place in the state. The Hawks finished the season with a conference record of 10-3. Much of this year's success is owed to Coach Rhonda Wall who motivated the team to their best finish in school history. In addition, Hawthorne player Ben Cok received an individual honor as an All Tournament Player.
